**40 Days for Life saves 458 babies.**

Palm Sunday March 28<sup>th</sup> marked the end of another successful international 40 Days for Life Campaign. This Lenten campaign ran in 167 cities and saved 458 babies. Little Rock and Fayetteville both ran successful 40 Days for Life Campaigns and both were well supported by the Knights of Columbus. The Knights of Columbus was instrumental from the start of 40 Days for Life in College Station Texas. The Knights were the guys who handled the Knight Shift for 24 hour coverage at the Planned Parenthood clinic there.

The Director of the College Station, TX Planned Parenthood clinic has since quit Planned Parenthood and joined the Pro Life movement, due to constant pressure from Planned Parenthood Corporate to increase their profits by increasing abortions. Planned Parenthood is truly an Evil Empire. The Little Rock 40 Days recorded 7 baby saves over the 40 Days. On Sat. March 27<sup>th</sup> the abortion mill had its third visit from an ambulance. We found out later the young woman had to have a full hysterectomy from the abortion mills mistake. Yet another example of the lie that abortion is now or ever will be safe. Every abortion ends with one dead and one woman scarred for life. May we overcome the lies of the culture of death and reduce abortion through the truth of the Culture of Life. Imagine the potential of the 468 lives we know to be saved from this 40 day campaign. Imagine that this is a mere fraction of the babies saved and attitudes changed by people praying on the sidewalk in front of abortion mills all over this country and several other countries.

Congratulations Arkansas Knights of Columbus. Your generosity is outstanding. The 2009 fund raising campaign contributions totaled \$41,029.00. This is a 60% increase over the previous year.

These funds will be distributed during the 2010-2011 fraternal year, which begins July 1, 2010, to the Diocesan Ministries we pledged to support. At the State Council Budget meeting held February 21 at the Clarksville Council 05725 home, the budget committee was very pleased to have the additional funds to prepare the Special Fund Budget for 2010-2011. The Special Fund Budget is the vehicle by which Catholic Charities, The Arkansas Catholic, Vocations Ministry, Respect Life office receive donations from the Arkansas Knights of Columbus.

Through your generosity we will increase our donation to the Arkansas Catholic by 57%. This will enable the Arkansas Knights of Columbus to sponsor the Arkansas Catholic in the Classroom Project by sending 15 copies of the paper each week to about 20 Catholic Schools during the school year. In the upcoming months my newsletter article will contain details regarding our donation to another Diocesan Ministry we have pledged to support through the resolution process. 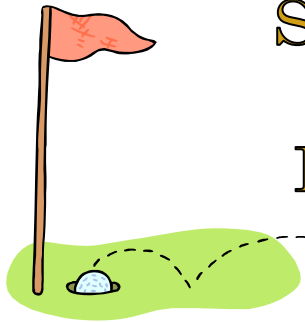
